Additional assignments included designation as a Police Instructor for municipal, county, and state investigative agencies in special weapons and tactics, firearms-self-defense, riot control, crime scene investigation, interrogation techniques and Risk Management/Crime Prevention.

Mr. Stephenson was a supervisory Agent in the Organized Crime/Surveillance unit. Mr. Stephenson was the case agent involved in the investigation of the distribution of narcotics and its sale and use by professional sports figures in Kansas City. Mr. Stephenson supervised the air operations surveillance squad investigating monies being skimmed by the Kansas City Organized family from Las Vegas Casinos; which resulted in the arrest and conviction of major Organized crime figures in Las Vegas, Chicago and Kansas City.
