For more than thirty-five years, I have been involved in the construction industry, with an expertise in Building Code Application and interpretation. I have dealt extensively with the application and interpretation of the Uniform Building Code as well as the state of California Building Code.

Code and Construction Consultant

For the last nineteen years I have provided Code and Construction consultation to Cities, Agencies, Attorneys, Insurance Companies, Developers, Contractors and Individuals. I have represented the above groups during construction, investigations, depositions and court testimony. Representation has been in several dozen cases with about three dozen resulting in depositions and/or court testimony.

Experience as a Building Official And chief Building Inspector

I graduated from San Bernardino Valley College in 1963.

I returned to San Bernardino Valley College to complete a thirty-three unit major in Building Inspection Technology, and received my certificate in Building Inspection Technology in 1976. Since that time, I have worked as a Building Official, a Chief Building Inspector. and as an Instructor of Building Inspection and Code technology.

I was the Building Official for the Town of Apple Valley for approximately one and a half years as well as the Building official for the City of Yucaipa for the same length of time. In these positions I was the chief administrative officer in charge of the application and interpretation of the building codes.



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I was the Chief Building Inspector for the County of San Bernardino for five years, where I was in charge of (1) Interpreting and applying the building codes to ensure compliance and (2) Training building inspectors in the application and interpretation of the building codes. As Chief Building Inspector, I also acted as the Building Official for the County of San Bernardino in the officials absence. As a Building official and a Chief Building Inspector, I regularly used and interpreted the building codes on behalf of the cities and counties described above.

Experience Teaching Code Application and Interpretation

My expertise in building inspection technology and building code application and interpretation led to my being hired as an Instructor and the Program Director of the Building Inspection Technology Program at San Bernardino Valley College, where I taught for eighteen years (1979 through 1997).

CERTIFICATIONS

I have been a Certified Building Inspector for approximately 35 years, a Certified Building Official for approximately 21 years and a Member of Both the California Building Official and the International Conference of Building Officials ("ICBO") for approximately 35 years. The ICBO is the organization which approves and publishes the Uniform Building Code (now ICC, International Code Council). I have certification by the State of California as a Construction Inspector and a State of California Teaching Credential.
