Deposition: \$ 600.00 per hour, **portal to portal** including commute time, **plus** Business Class airline travel, out of pocket expenses, tolls, meals, lodging, and taxi service, where applicable. Two-hour minimum charge. Please bring a blank check to the deposition made payable to Alan Klein, M.D.. The deposition may begin when the check is presented. Payment is to be made at the close of the deposition. You agree to bear the sole responsibility for collecting payment from opposing counsel.

Trial: \$ 600.00 per hour, **portal to portal** including commute time within Denver. Out of pocket expenses, tolls, meals, and taxi service, will be billed separately. A two hour minimum charge (\$1200) must be received one week prior to trial, and is non-refundable. \$ 6000.00 per day of travel or testimony, for trials away from Denver, minimum of one day. Payment in full by cashier’s check, plus full fare Business Class airline tickets, must be received one week prior to trial. Daily fee and tickets are non-refundable if trial is cancelled.

All charges except Retainer and Fee for Trial are payable in full immediately following delivery of each service and receipt of bill. Prompt payment insures that no interest will accrue. ⁱ*
