DESCRIPTION OF TEACHING

Over 20 years of full time work as an attending radiologist at large academic medical centers, including hands-on teaching, formal core lectures and mock board reviews to residents and fellows in training, Grand Round presentations, Continuing Medical Education (CME) courses, and invited presentations at the regional, national and international levels.

DESCRIPTION OF CLINICAL PRACTICE

<u>Areas of clinical focus:</u> interventional oncology, portal hypertension, management of bleeding, and management of chronic venous insufficiency.

<u>Typical interventions performed:</u> cover the full spectrum of non-neurological IR procedures including (but not limited to):

- ✓ Arterial interventions for peripheral arterial disease (percutaneous transluminal balloon angioplasty (PTA), bare and covered stents placement, cryoplasty, atherectomy, etc.), endovascular repair of thoracic and abdominal aortic aneurysms and dissections with stent grafts and fenestration, pre-operative tumor embolization (e.g., renal, bone) and embolization of liver tumors (bland embolization, chemoembolization, drug-eluting beads, radioembolization with both SIR Spheres and Theraspheres), partial splenic embolization, endovascular treatment of trauma (e.g., pelvic bleeding, post-partum hemorrhage), acute bleeding in various territories (e.g., gastrointestinal hemorrhage, hemoptysis), and percutaneous and intra-arterial treatment of arteriovenous malformations. I have experience with multiple embolization materials (Gelfoam, coils and microcoils, particles, NBCA or Onyx glues, ethanol, etc.).
- ✓ Venous procedures such as transjugular intrahepatic portosystemic shunts (TIPS) creation and revision, transjugular liver biopsy and pressure measurements, esogastric variceal embolization, balloon retrograde transvenous obliteration (BRTO) of gastric varices and gastrorenal/ gastrocaval shunts, transhepatic portal venous interventions (PTA, stent), gonadal vein embolization for varicocele or pelvic congestion syndrome, renal and adrenal venous sampling, inferior petrosal venous sinus sampling, venous access (placement, repair, and exchange of PICC)

lines, temporary and tunneled central catheters, and Port-a-Caths), fibrin sheath stripping, arteriovenous hemodialysis fistula interventions (including cutting balloon), peripheral limb venograms, pulmonary arteriogram and suction thrombectomy, venous thrombolysis and thrombectomy with various devices (pulse spray pharmacomechanical thrombolysis, EKOS[®] system, AngioJet[®], Omnisonics[®]), caval filter placement and removal, vena cava stent placement, endovenous thermal (laser and radiofrequency) or adhesive glue (VenaSeal) closure of incompetent saphenous veins, sclerotherapy of varicose veins and of venous or lymphatic malformations, and lymphangiogram and thoracic duct embolization.

✓ Percutaneous non-vascular procedures including transhepatic cholangiography and biliary drain placement (PTBD), balloon cholangioplasty, biliary stents placement (plastic and metallic) and management, percutaneous nephrostomy, nephroureteral stents placement and management, percutaneous gastrostomy and gastrojejunostomy tubes, percutaneous insertions and revisions of tunneled peritoneal dialysis catheters, percutaneous tumor ablations (radiofrequency, cryoablation, or irreversible electroporation), intra-operative ultrasound and open and laparoscopic radiofrequency ablations of liver tumors (in collaboration with the gastrointestinal oncologic surgery team), intraabdominal drainages and biopsies, image-guided punctures and aspirations, insertions of fiducial markers and SpaceOAR gel, and percutaneous kyphoplasties.
