As an assigned faculty mentor within the Emergency Medicine residency program, I provide structured quarterly mentorship sessions to designated residents from 2019 – present, supplemented by monthly check-ins and completion of required program evaluations. For Emory medical students, I have served as a mentor through the formal Faculty Affinity Group mentorship program from 2022 – present; additional medical students listed received mentorship following clinical rotations or through professional referrals during their medical education. For Grady Hospital EMS paramedics, I provide longitudinal mentorship consisting of monthly four-hour clinical preceptorship shifts in the emergency department and individualized guidance supporting their career transition from paramedic to physician. This comprehensive mentorship encompasses clinical skill development, psychosocial support, and professional advancement across all mentee populations.
