Focus of practice

- Primarily geriatric psychology for the past twelve years.
- Independent assessments for people in crisis, residential evaluations, multidisciplinary team work with psychiatrists, social workers, Adult Protective Services, probate conservators, probate attorneys, Offices of the Los Angeles Public Guardian, County Counsel, District Attorney, and Public Defender.
