My clinical practice primarily involves the management of patients with complex liver, pancreas, and biliary disorders (benign and malignant). For 19 years I have collaborated with my colleagues in medical oncology, gastroenterology, and radiology in the multidisciplinary management of complex hepato-pancreato-biliary and oncology patients. From 2014 to 2021, I was the director of an ACGME accredited residency training program in general surgery. During this time as residency director, I developed and implemented educational curricula and residency training policies while certifying my general surgery residents for board eligibility and mentoring medical students seeking general surgery residency training positions. I am a co-investigator in a DOD funded translational research project — one involving a new potential immunotherapy for hepatocellular carcinoma. We are currently applying for an FDA New Drug Investigation project approval to begin human clinical trials.
