Randy Wall is a snow sports expert about skiing, sledding, snow tubing, and all winter sporting activities. He addresses inherent risk, and ski area operations. He is also a Civil Engineer licensed in 13 states. His experience is garnered over a 40-year career.

Mr. Wall serves as an expert witness in cases involving sports, sporting facilities including runs, resorts, safety practices, and industry best practices. When infrastructure and regulations are involved, he applies engineering expertise to land development, municipal, regulatory, structural engineering, and infrastructure questions around snow sports. In 2011, Mr. Wall was awarded a Master's Degree in Public Administration reflecting research and peer-reviewed writing about Public Administration with application to municipal and other regulated public entities.

Professional Background

Mr. Wall's experience is broad and deep. In addition to his engineering background, he has become a leader and policy maker since he obtained his first certification as a ski instructor in 1982 by the Professional Ski Instructors of America (PSIA).

He holds 5 levels of certification and 2 levels of accreditation and has served at the highest level of leadership nationally as a Region Director, Discipline Chairperson, Education Team Member, Trainer, and Examiner for multiple PSIA regions, and is a Certified L100 Race Coach and Official by the United States Ski and Snowboard Association (USSA).
