Randy Wall is a snow sports expert about skiing, sledding, snow tubing, and winter sporting activities. He addresses snow sports risk, liability, and ski area operations. He is also a Civil Engineer licensed in 15 states. His experience is garnered over a 40-year career in the snow sports industry.

Mr. Wall serves as an expert witness in cases involving snow sports, sporting facilities including runs, resorts, safety practices, and industry best practices. When infrastructure and regulations are involved, he applies engineering expertise to land development, municipal, regulatory, engineering, and infrastructure questions around snow sports. When accidents or collisions are involved, Mr. Wall combines his knowledge, skills, education, training, and experience in snow sports *and* engineering to reconstruct accidents to support his expert opinions.

In 2011, Mr. Wall was awarded a Master's Degree in Public Administration reflecting research and peer-reviewed writing about Public Administration with application to municipal and other regulated public entities.

Mr. Wall's experience is broad and deep. In addition to his engineering background, he has become a leader and educator since he obtained his first certification as a ski instructor in 1982 by the Professional Ski Instructors of America (PSIA).
