CLINICAL PROFICIENCIES

Surgical: Proficient in implant fixture placement including single unit, short bridges, overdentures and many full arch rehabilitations. In house design and 3D printing of surgical guides, occlusal splints, and models. Crestal and lateral window sinus lifts. Socket preservation and select horizontal ridge augmentation. Surgical extractions including impacted thirds. Alveoplasty, torus reduction, and frenectomies. Certified in oral conscious sedation. Prior history of parenteral sedation certification however, I prefer utilizing a separate anesthetist.

Restorative: Direct restorations, crowns, veneers, bridges.

Pediatrics: Traditional modalities (direct restorative, pulpotomies, SSC, space maintenance). Conservative management (SDF, Hall crowns, SMART techniques).

Endodontics: Initial non surgical therapy including molar endodontics. Selective anterior retreats and apicoectomies. Pediatric pulpotomies and pulpectomies. Internal whitening.

Orthodontics: Invisalign certified. Pediatric RPE.

Dental Technologies: CBCT based and prosthetically driven implant planning. In office 3D printing and milling. Utilization of AI in administration and business management. Photogrammetry in fully digital and hybrid workflows. Prosthetically driven treatment planning via fully digital workflows including virtual articulation and dynamic occlusal records.

AI in education and diagnostics. Teledentistry in preventive health and patient education. Airway driven interceptive pediatric growth and development. 3D printing in dental education for pre surgical/operative preparation. 3D printed prosthetics and restorations in dental outreach and community health settings.
