Flat Fee: \$3,900.00 Yearly forecast calculation of lifetime prosthetic costs for a single amputation site to include

prosthetic device illustrations and line-item component details.

Expert Witness & Consultation Services: \$425. 00 Per Hour
Case initiation fee includes:
