Dr. William E. Kennedy was accepted to the Emory University School of Medicine, Atlanta, Georgia after his junior year in the College of Arts and Sciences at Emory. He graduated with the MD degree from the Emory School of Medicine in 1965.

During the next five years, he completed a rotating internship and a fully accredited orthopedic residency at the Akron General Hospital and the Akron Children's Hospital in Akron, Ohio.

From 1970 to 1972 he served on active duty as a lieutenant commander, orthopedic surgeon, at the Naval Hospital in Pensacola, Florida.

In 1972, he joined Watauga Orthopaedics in Johnson City, Tennessee, where he worked full time in the practice of orthopedic surgery until August, 1998 at which time he retired from the treatment side of orthopedics. Since then he has continued his work as an Independent Medical Examiner in the field of orthopedics.

In 1972 he was certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery. The following year, he became a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons and a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons.

He is certified by the American Board of Independent Medical Examiners.

He resigned from all hospital staff positions as of July 31, 1998 at the time of his retirement from treatment and surgery. Prior to that date he was on the active staff at North Side Hospital and at Johnson City Medical Center Hospital in Johnson City. He was also on the consulting staff at Northeast Tennessee Rehabilitation Hospital and at Johnson City Specialty Hospital in Johnson City; and he was on the courtesy staff at Unicoi County Hospital in Erwin, Tennessee.

After his arrival in Johnson City and for approximately twenty years he was a team physician for East Tennessee State University. He was an active member of the American Orthopaedic Society for Sports Medicine.

He is licensed to practice medicine in the State of Tennessee.
