### **Consultation and Trial Fee Schedule for Dr. Noah T. Kaufman**

Review of medical records and other materials related to trial, along with all research in support of the retaining party will be billed at \$600 per hour.

Trial preparation (email, video conferencing and telephone ) will be billed at \$750 per hour.

All in-person work, including expert consultation, testimony and investigation assistance will be billed at \$3200 per day (regardless of actual hours).

Travel time will be billed at \$600 per hour, not to exceed \$1800 per day.

Please note that because of the time commitment made in these cases, any cancellation of services less than 96 hours from time of service/travel will result in payment for one day's services (\$3200).

Retaining party will be responsible for arranging and paying for transportation and lodging. Transportation must be arranged at least 2 weeks prior to intended departure unless specifically arranged in advance.

Per diem will be paid by retaining party at the Federal Government rate.

To initiate a consultation with me, please contact me by email or call me. There is no charge for an initial consultation.

During that initial consultation, we will discuss your case with particular attention to what went wrong and who the negligent parties may be.

Should you decide to retain me, you will need to send me the records to be reviewed along with a retainer. The amount of the retainer will vary depending on the volume of records to be reviewed and whether or not you will want me to produce a written report or affidavit along with my review of records. Alternatively, we can meet and discuss at your offices at my hourly review rate.

After I finish my review of the records, I will schedule a telephone consultation with you to discuss the case. Some cases are straightforward and do not require much explanation; other cases are exceedingly complex and may engender a lengthy explanation of the medical issues that have informed my opinions. I always endeavor to make the medicine understandable and the reasons for my opinions clear and defensible.

If you then name me as your designated emergency medicine expert in the case, I will submit to you a one-page agreement regarding my services which we will need to sign. All subsequent work will be by retainer, any unused portion of which will be refunded should the case settle and/or my services are no longer needed.

## EXPERT WITNESS REAFFIRMATION

As a member of the medical profession and the American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP), I hereby affirm my duty, when giving evidence or testifying as an expert witness, to do so solely in accordance with the merits of the case. Furthermore, I declare that I will uphold the following professional principles in providing expert evidence or expert witness testimony.

1. I will always be truthful, and I will abide by the Principles of Ethics of the American College of Emergency Physicians.
2. I will conduct a thorough, fair and impartial review of the facts and the medical care provided, including any and all relevant information.
3. I will provide evidence or testify only in matters in which I have recent clinical experience and knowledge in the areas of medicine that are the subject of the case or proceeding.
4. I will evaluate the medical care provided in light of generally accepted clinical standards, neither condemning performance that falls within generally accepted practice standards nor condoning performance that falls below these standards.
5. I will evaluate the medical care provided in light of the generally accepted standards that prevailed at the time of the occurrence giving rise to the case.
6. I will provide evidence or testimony that is complete, objective, scientifically based, and likely to assist in achieving a just resolution of the proceeding.
7. I will make a clear distinction in my testimony between a departure from accepted practice standards and an untoward outcome.
8. I will make every effort to determine and to specify whether I believe there is a causal relationship between any substandard practice and the medical outcome.
9. I will submit my testimony to peer review, if requested by a professional organization to which I belong.
10. I will not accept compensation that is contingent upon the outcome of the litigation.
