Representative Successes

Instituted 1st, 2nd, and 3rd line of defense segregation of duties. Deliver monthly portfolio and quarterly Board risk management reports. Promote enterprise risk culture and awareness. Lead provincial and federal financial regulator relationships.

Supporting Business Growth: Risk management and credit structuring roles have supported significant growth including quadrupling of assets through organic and acquisition initiatives. Closed on 2 financial institution amalgamations through M&A process.
